

## Instructions for submitting comments to the CPUC

For submitting Comments on CPUC Resolution E-4907, please use the CPUC's [Informal Comment Process](#).

Be sure to include in the subject line of your letter and/or email: Agenda ID #16190 ENERGY DIVISION RESOLUTION E-4907 "Registration Process for Community Choice Aggregators"

**Write to CPUC** – Send CPUC a letter or an email with comments on any proceeding. The Public Advisor routes all comments to the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and to the Commissioners' offices. The only downside of this method is that it only goes to the assigned Commissioner and assigned ALJ not all Commissioners. In your letter, request that the Public Advisor forward it on to all Commissioners.
