# COVID-19 Community Relief Response

\$1,500,000 from EBCE Operating Budget

- \$1.1m in grants to each of EBCE's 12 Members Jurisdictions
- \$110K in grants to Medical Institutions
- \$70k in grants to Meals on Wheels and Alameda County Foodbank
- \$220k in \$10k grants to 22 Alameda County CBOs

\$182,500 from EBCE Customers and Partners to Benefit Alameda County Foodbank

\$250,000 from EBCE Solar Energy Partner Clearway Energy

- 28 community grants
- Tens of thousands of masks for the community
