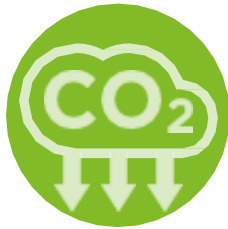
# Community & Industry Impact



**270,000+** households and businesses receiving clean electricity from carbon-free sources



**\$28.7 million** in electricity savings for customers, **\$52.7 million** in savings since SVCE's start



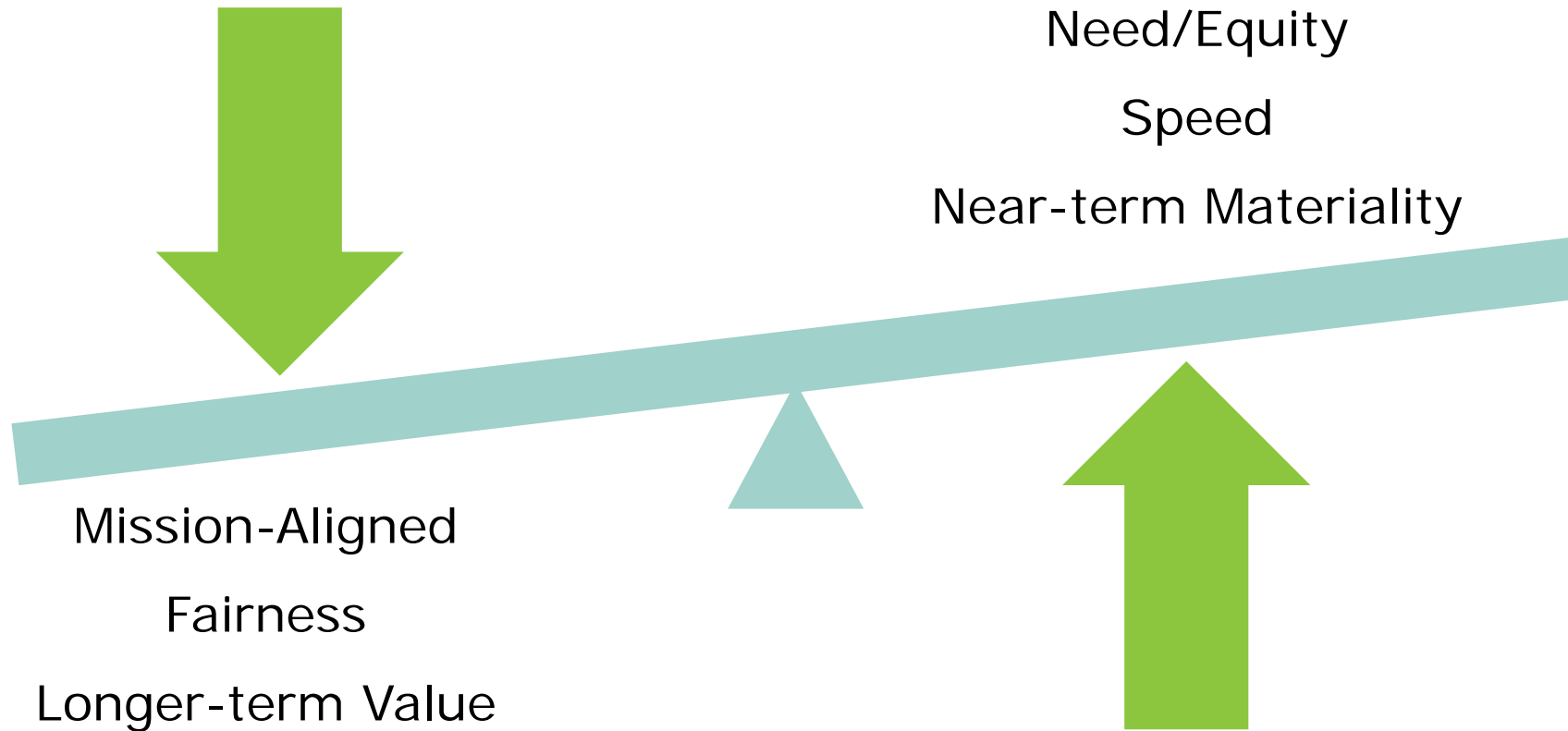
**537.9 million pounds** GHG emissions avoided and **19.8%** reduction in overall emissions from 2015



**\$970+ million** commitment to new renewables, and local programs for **transportation and building electrification**

# \$10 Million for Customer Relief & Community Resilience Programs

The programs will include direct support for:

- Income-qualified CARE/FERA customers
- Local small businesses
- Contractor workforce through online electrification training
- Member communities through energy resilience projects

# 1) Customer Relief Programs

## Objectives:

- Provide immediate relief to vulnerable residential populations
- Provide support to local small business community



# 1a) Residential Bill Credits – \$2.5 Million

- \$100 Bill Credit for Residential CARE/FERA customers
  - Over 24,000 customer accounts currently with CARE/FERA
  - Increments of \$50 on-bill credits, automatically applied for June & July statements



# 1b) Small Business Bill Credits- \$1 Million



- \$250 Bill Credit for Small Business commercial accounts
  - 4,000 credits to businesses who qualify and apply
  - Letters will be sent to approximately 10,000 customers

## 2) Workforce Relief Programs

### Objectives:

- Provide immediate financial relief to contractor workforce
- Expand awareness of electrification technologies & provide valuable training

## 2a) Workforce Relief: Contractor Training - \$1.5 Million

- Provide \$500 relief stipend to licensed contractors, apprentices & journeymen workforce upon completion of training
  - Five self-paced online courses focused on building electrification technologies
  - Delivered through local community college platform



## 2b) Workforce Relief: Installation Incentive \$0.5 Million



- Allow participants in the training to apply electrification knowledge
  - Up to \$3,000 incentive for installation of batteries, heat pump water heaters, heat pump furnace, electric stovetops, EV chargers
  - Installation at their residence or workplace

## 3) Community Resilience Programs

### Objectives:

- Increase community resilience
- Support local job creation
- Accelerate grid decarbonization

# 3a) Community Resilience: Regional Planning & Technical Assistance -\$1 Million

- Regional tools to aid communities in the planning and technical aspects of resilience projects
  - SVCE to provide centralized contracting for partners providing assistance and planning
  - Funding distributed based on load allocation of member agencies



## 3b) Community Resilience: Capital Support \$4 Million



- Local grants for shovel-ready resilience projects
  - Projects can include energy storage, capacity etc.
  - Funding distributed based on load allocation of member agencies
